HELP LORD THE SOULS: Please note that there will be Mass celebrated this Mon 3 November at 9.30am. As the feast of All Souls, which is traditionally celebrated on 2 November, fell on a Sunday this year, it was celebrated as the feast of All Saints. Therefore, All Souls has been transferred this year to Mon 3 Nov. During the Mass of All Souls we shall especially remember those whose funerals have been celebrated at Christ the King during the past twelve months and light a candle as each of their names are read out. May they rest in peace and rise in glory.

NOVEMBER is the month of the Holy Souls. Please take the opportunity of writing the names of loved ones who have died in the special book in the Lady Chapel. They will be prayed for.

REMBEMBRANCE SUNDAY – Next Sunday 9 November is Remembrance Sunday. The 10.30am Mass will be a Requiem Mass for those who have died in the two World Wars.

SECOND COLLECTION NEXT WEEKEND will be for THE ARCHBISHOP'S APPEAL which funds three key mission areas: Youth and Evangelization, Our Faith in Action and Clergy Care & Formation.

BLESSING OF THE GRAVES: There will be a Ceremony of the Graves at Garth Road Cemetery on Sunday 9 Nov at 2.30pm. The clergy and people of Merton Deanery will be attending. All, of course, are welcome to attend in praying for all who have died but we especially invite anybody who has a family member or friend laid to rest at the cemetery. May they rest in peace and rise in glory.

A SPECIAL INVITATION: We really hope you will be coming to the Induction Mass of Canon Liam at 6pm on Saturday 15th November. This is the official ceremony when Canon Gerard Bradley, The Episcopal Vicar for South West, will present Canon Liam to us as our new Parish Priest. During the ceremony, Canon Liam kneels before the Altar and prays the Creed, is presented with keys of the Church and led to the Presidential Chair. Members of Canon Liam's family will be joining us as well as people from his previous parish of Maidstone. We want to give them a classic Christ the King Welcome. So, let us worship together in good number and party on like we've never parted before. We also want to get the word out there about our new Parish Priest and this great celebration that's going to take place. There are a number of cards at the back of the Church titled 'A Special Invitation'. We ask you please to take some and post them through letterboxes around your neighbourhood. It would be especially good if you could drop them through anybody you know who is Catholic but not attending Christ the King. We would love to see them here.
